CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). Food shall be protected from sources of contamination and stored in a clean, dry location at least 6 inches above the floor.

Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, & clean

Paint peeling behind door in laundry room.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.
