1.	Hernando eSchool classes are on-line classes taught by Hernando County teachers. Completed courses earned through Hernando eSchool will go on the student's academic transcript and are accepted by Challenger K8 School.
2.	Courses taken through Hernando eSchool take approximately the same time to complete as courses taken at CK8. That is, a semester course will take approximately 18 weeks to complete and a yearlong course 36 weeks.
3.	Students may take Hernando eSchool courses to replace missing credits from failures or to accelerate curriculum.
